Critical Fire Weather Conditions Expected

It only takes one spark to start a wildfire!

Do your part to keep them from starting!

- ✓ Properly discard cigarettes, do not throw them out the window!
- ✓ Avoid parking on dry grass or brush.
- ✓ Avoid driving on a flat tire.
- ✓ Avoid dragging chains behind vehicles
- ✓ Avoid activities with open flames
- ✓ Avoid power equipment that creates sparks
- ✓ Obey burn bans.

Critical Fire Weather Conditions

- √ Warm Temperatures
- √ Very Low Humidity
- ✓ Strong Winds
- ✓ Unstable Atmosphere

Please avoid anything that could cause a Spark!
