# **CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Trustee Wolberg introduced a resolution to be presented after Executive Session.

Trustee Anaya made a motion to approve the Agenda with the addition; motion seconded by Trustee Wolberg. Motion carried unanimously.

President Dorough approved the Agenda with the addition.

# **CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL PREVIOUS MINUTES**

Trustee Wolberg made a motion to approve the minutes from March 25, 2020, as presented; motion seconded by Trustee Aguilar. Motion carried unanimously.

President Dorough approved the minutes from March 25, 2020, as presented.

### **MEMBER COMMENTS**

Manager Herrera reported that no members had called in or were present for Member Comments.

### **CONSIDERATION OF 2019 FINANCIAL AUDIT**

Manager Herrera stated that the Trey Rowe, CPA Partner with BSGM, was joining them via teleconference.

Mr. Rowe thanked the Board for allowing him to present via teleconference; and proceeded to go over the December 31, 2019, and 2018 Audit report stating that BSGM did not have any findings related to significant deficiencies, material weaknesses and found SEC records in great shape, offering a clean opinion of the Cooperative financials. Mr. Rowe answered questions posed by the Trustees.

President Dorough thanked Mr. Rowe for his presentation.

# **MANAGER'S REPORT**

Manager Herrera reported on the expenditure check register totaling \$917,774.96 for March 2020 and proceeded to answer questions posed by the Trustees.

President Dorough thanked Manager Herrera for the Expenditure Report for March 2020.

Manager Herrera reported that SEC had to use both the existing Mastercard credit cards and the new Visa cards for the expenditures for March 2020. Manager Herrera reported to the Board of Trustees this would be the last month that SEC had to use the Mastercard credit cards.

President Dorough thanked Manager Herrera for the credit card report for March 2020.

Manager Herrera reported for the Engineering Report, and SEC has received approval from the Bureau of Land Management for an upcoming line extension near the Bruton Ranch that will install two miles of single-phase power line. Manager Herrera stated that Mr. Williams had reported the crews are preparing to start the changing out of poles identified upon completion of the pole inspections. Manager Herrera reported that 280 poles would need to be changed with 70 located between Datil and Pie Town, and the remaining 210 along Highway 380 with a few located on the White Sands Missile Range. Manager Herrera mentioned that our RUS Loan had been approved and we are waiting for the final documentation so SEC can start projects included in our 4-year CWP. Manager Herrera stated that site visits are on hold due to the COVID-19 and are being considered on a case by case.

President Dorough thanked Manager Herrera for the Engineering Report for March 2020.

Manager Herrera provided an update to COVID-19 procedures SEC is following and provided the Board of Trustees with SEC Pandemic Response Plan 2020. Manager Herrera reported

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that SEC was continuing to work on getting masks and disinfecting wipes to have in stock for employees. Manager Herrera stated that SEC would keep its doors closed through the end of the governor's executive order but is working on getting shields to put up once the lobby does reopen.

President Dorough thanked Manager Herrera for the COVID-19 Update.

Manager Herrera concluded by reporting that SEC recently hired the firm ARC Media, who is providing additional content to our Facebook page. Manager Herrera also reported, as previously mentioned, Ricky Williams is retiring soon from SEC. Manager Herrera welcomes Steve Dettmer, SEC's new Line Superintendent and Steve will be working with Mr. Williams during this transition.

President Dorough thanked Manager Herrera for the Manager's Report for March 2020.

Ms. Montoya carefully reviewed in detail the RUS Form 7 Report for March 2020 and proceeded to answer questions posed by the Trustees.

Mr. Montoya reviewed the March Safety Report and provided a COVID-19 update with crews in the field. Mr. Montoya proceeded to answer questions posed by the Trustees.

# OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE REPORT

#### CONSTRUCTION/MAINTENANCE REPORT

Mr. Williams reported on February activities as crews completed 57 service orders, with 27 of them being for area light issues. Mr. Williams stated that 13 work orders had been completed, with 43 work orders closing. Mr. Williams noted that crews trimmed or cut down 232 trees. Mr. Williams reported crews assisted Tri-State as they were doing maintenance and near our distribution lines.

Trustee Anaya mentioned that recently it was Lineman Appreciation Day and thanked our line crews for their hard work as well as everyone in the office.

Mr. Williams reported on March activities as crews completed 59 service orders, with 26 of them being for area light issues. Mr. Williams stated that 23 work orders had been completed, with one (1) work order closing. Mr. Williams noted that crews trimmed or cut down 531 trees. Mr. Williams reported the planned outage at the Socorro Substation had to be postponed due to COVID-19, but it will be rescheduled for later this year. Mr. Williams stated that a standard operating procedure was being developed for changing reclosers during high winds. Mr. Williams continued stating that crews will start working on the poles replacements resulting from the pole inspections and he proceeded to answer questions posed by the Trustees.

# **OUTAGE REPORTS**

Mr. Williams gave a review of the Cooperative Response Center (CRC) Outage Report for February 2020, stating 29 outage reports had been turned in by SEC crews. Mr. Williams provided a review of the CRC Outage Report for March 2020, stating 26 outage reports had been turned in by SEC crews.

President Dorough thanked Mr. Williams for the Operations and Maintenance Report for February and March 2020.

President Dorough thanked Manager Herrera for the NMRECA Report.

President Dorough thanked Trustee Wolberg for the MRGEDA Report.

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Dorough reported that the Socorro Electric Foundation 2019 Form 990-PF had been made available to the Board of Trustees.

#### STANDING COMMITTEE REPORT

Trustee Anaya reported on the Standing Committee Meeting held on April 15, 2020, with recommendations to the full Board of Trustees.

President Dorough thanked Trustee Anaya for the Standing Committee Report.

# **NEW BUSINESS**

# Board Policy 106 - Ethics Committee

Manager Herrera reported that Board Policy 106 – Ethics Committee had been reviewed by the Standing Committee on February 19, 2020 and had been sent back for clarification. Manager Herrera stated that he reached out to Aaron Christensen, consulting attorney, who provided additional changes that were provided to the Standing Committee on March 18, 2020. Manager Herrera reported it was the recommendation of the Committee to approve Board Policy 106 – Ethics Committee with revisions.

After discussion, Trustee Hawkes made a motion to refer Policy 106 – Ethics Committee back to the Standing Committee for further review; motion seconded by Trustee Wolberg. Motion carried unanimously.

# Board Policy 113 - Delegation of Authority from the Board of Trustees to the General Manager

Manager Herrera reported that the Standing Committee reviewed Board Policy 113 – Delegation of Authority From the Board of Trustees to the General Manager, and it was the recommendation of the Committee to approve Board Policy 113 – Delegation of Authority From the Board of Trustees to the General Manager with revisions.

After much discussion, Trustee Nelson made a motion to accept the Standing Committee's recommended revisions to Board Policy 113 – Delegation of Authority from the Board of Trustees to the General Manager with corrections; motion seconded by Trustee Wolberg. Motion carried unanimously.

President Dorough called for a ten (10) minute recess due to a loss of telephone connection with the SEC main office at 3:00 p.m.

President Dorough called the meeting back to order at 3:10 p.m.

After discussion, Trustee Nelson made a motion to accept the Standing Committee's recommended revisions to Board Policy 126 – Whistleblower Protection with corrections; motion seconded by Trustee Wolberg. Motion carried unanimously.

### 2020 Load Forecast

Manager Herrera reported that SEC works with Tri-State in providing detailed billing and metering data to help produce a 10-Year Load Forecast projecting an estimate of the amount of energy to be provided to the SEC. Manager Herrera stated that SEC had recently updated the Load Forecast for the RUS loan process, and the forecast would become an annual process.

After discussion, Trustee Wolberg made a motion to approve the 2020 10-Year Load Forecast; motion seconded by Trustee Nelson. Motion carried unanimously.

# Consideration of Capital Credit Estate Retirements

Manager Herrera reported that SEC General Counsel Lorna Wiggins Esq. had previously reviewed the Patronage Estate Capital Retirement requests as provided in the Trustee's BoardPaq. Ms. Wiggins reviewed the retirement documents and stated that they appeared to be in order and were ready for the Board's consideration:

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After discussion, Trustee Wolberg made a motion for a resolution stating that SEC will comply with the compel order recently given by NM PRC; motion seconded by Trustee Hawkes. Motion carried unanimously.

Trustee Anaya made a motion to direct the General Manager or President Dorough to instruct SEC attorneys as needed regarding the mandamus or appeal; motion seconded by Trustee Nelson. Motion carried with one abstention.

# SET DATE/TIME FOR REGULAR MEETING

After discussion, Trustee Anaya made a motion to set the date and time of Committee meetings for May 20, 2020, at 2:00 p.m. and the next regularly scheduled Board Meeting for May 27, 2020, at 2:00 p.m.; motion seconded by Trustee Hawkes. Motion carried unanimously.
